

TAX-AIDE OFFERS FREE INCOME TAX PREPARATION

The IRS and AARP jointly sponsor a program staffed by volunteers who are trained to assist in the preparation and electronic filing of an income tax return at NO COST TO YOU, the taxpayer. Appointments and/or walk-in assistance are available at several sites. If you have questions, visit “AARP Foundation Tax-Aide Locator” online or stop by one of the sites.

Taxpayers we can serve:

ALL AGES, who have income from employment, retirement, unemployment, self-employment business (up to \$25,000 in expenses, no employees, no inventory & no loss), as well as those needing to file to claim a wide variety of deductions and credits

Taxpayers we CANNOT serve:

Those with rental income, depreciation, home office, or self-employment business with a loss, expenses exceeding \$25,000, inventory, or employees

Taxpayers MUST bring:

- 1) Social Security cards for ALL persons on the tax return
- 2) Photo identification for taxpayer and spouse
- 3) All 2023 tax documents, such as statements of income from wages, retirement, Social Security, interest, dividends, brokerage statements, and information on college expenses
- 4) Information on your medical coverage and, if you received one, your 1095A, 1095B, or 1095C
- 5) A list of all your deductions plus tax documents showing mortgage interest and property taxes
- 6) Your checkbook with a check showing your routing and account numbers, or a statement/letter from your bank showing this information. This is for direct deposit of your refund or withdrawal of the amount due.
- 7) Last year's tax return

- Bring in any information you think we might find helpful and let us sort it out.
- Please plan to arrive early. We try not to begin preparation of a new return during the last half hour before closing time, to ensure that returns are completed before volunteers are expected to vacate the space used.
